Class Descriptions

Clay Club: Monday Clay Club and Thursday Clay Club is for Ages 7 and up. Beginner students can learn handbuilding and wheel throwing techniques and advanced students can sharpen and expand their skills.

Art with Books: (Mondays, Ages 5-8) Younger students will try a variety of art materials from drawing to paint to clay to multimedia projects.

Studio Sampler: (Tuesdays, Ages 7-12) Students will try a variety of art materials from drawing to paint to clay to multimedia projects.

Art Exploration (Wednesdays for teens and young adults with special needs) Students will participate in the planning of their own projects and themes. A variety of art materials will be available for students to complete artwork.

Artist of the Week: (Thursdays, Ages 7-12) Learn about a different artist from history each week and create artwork inspired by each artist's work using a variety of art materials and your own unique style!

Art & Science: (Fridays, Ages 7-12) Explore the timeless connection between art and sciences! Illustrate scientific discoveries! Create artwork using scientific experimentation! The possibilities are endless!

The Art of Play: (Fridays 10 to 10:50 am, Ages 3-5, accompanied by parent/ adult) This class is for young preschool aged artists to come and experience color, texture, form...all that art has to offer! This class will focus more on experiencing art, playing with the materials, and having fun!
