- Coordination with Punch Projects for optional furnished lodging at 10630 N Thorp Highway, Thorp, WA
- An opportunity to get to know our local and regional community

Please read below for agreements;

- Artist will receive \$400 per week of residency totalling, \_\_\_\_\_.
- Artist will be responsible for their transportation between the residency and their home and necessary transportation between the residency in Thorp and studio location in Ellensburg (10 miles). Bringing a vehicle is highly encouraged. Artist may contact us for information on other transportation options.
- All art materials will be provided by the Artist and any remaining supplies, tools, artwork or other personal effects must be removed from studio or living space prior to leaving. Anything left behind will be disposed of at the discretion of Gallery One and Punch Projects. Gallery One has a right to terminate the residency at any time for misuse of the space, illegal, or improper behavior.
- The Artist's use of the studio space shall be for the creation and/or exhibition of art created by the Artist. The Artist shall comply with all rules, regulations, ordinances and statutes of the City of Ellensburg, County of Kittitas, State of Washington and the United States. In addition, Artist shall not cause or permit any activities or conditions in or around the artist studio space that are a nuisance or which interfere with or are disturbing to Gallery One, other tenants or others in the Stewart Building. Artist agrees not to use, store or dispose of any hazardous substances or environmental contaminants in an unsafe manner on or about the artist studio space and further agrees to indemnify, defend and hold the Gallery One harmless from any and all costs, fees, penalties, claims and/or liabilities against or imposed upon them as a result of any such use, storage or disposal. Artist's said covenant to indemnify, defend and hold the Gallery One harmless shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
- Gallery One reserves the right to enter on and in the artist studio space and residence space at reasonable times with 24 hour notice to inspect it for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not maintenance and repair obligations and other responsibilities of the Artist have been performed as agreed by the Artist, or to conduct facilities maintenance.

- Artist is also expected to comply with the Gallery One COVID- Protocol that can be found here: <https://www.gallery-one.org/covid-protocol/>
- The artwork created by the Artist remains the property of the Artist. The costs of packaging/shipping artwork to or from the Artist’s home or studio is the responsibility of the Artist. Unless the Artist is scheduled for an exhibit at Gallery One, proceeds from any artwork sales during the residency at Gallery One by the Artist are to be kept in full by the Artist. Gallery One promotes the Artist and any presentations, exhibition, community programs they participate in during the residency.
- Documentation, audio/visual and photography, made during the Artist’s residency, for example, residency activity, exhibition opening, exhibition documentation, etc., shall be the shared property of the Artist and Gallery One. The Artist agrees to allow reproduction of documentation for promotional use.
